PARENTAL CHECKS

We have a number of children in school who regularly use their own phone or electronic device to connect with friends outside of school. We have previously sent out information regarding setting parental controls and checking in with children regularly about their use of social media and online apps, so thank you for your support with this. However, we are receiving an increase in reports regarding unkind messages being sent to other children via text messages and group chat messages. These messages have sometimes been about other children in classes, who do not use online technology. When checking in with children, we urge you to regularly check on text messages they are sending to each other and remind them of the importance of being kind online as they would be face to face.

BREAKFAST CLUBS

Breakfast club will run on a **Monday, Wednesday** and **Thursday** starting from **7:45am**. Children are provided with a nutritious breakfast, compromising of a choice of healthy cereals, toast, fruit, yoghurt or pancakes. Children will participate in an activity until 8:35am when they will join the other children on the playground and be supervised by the teacher on duty.

The sessions are £5 per child per session, and can be paid for by BACs. To ensure the sustainability of the club, we will require parents and carers to sign up to this termly, as we need 2 members of staff to run it. You can select your days and we will offer places on a first come, first served basis. You do, however, need to book a minimum of I session per week. If you would like to book a place for the second term, please contact the school office by **Friday** 9th **February** to reserve your child's place.
